- ★ Transitionz programme implemented in 2009
- Aimed to improve transition from hospital to home
- Typical length of stay = 4 weeks
- ★ Learn necessary skills for re integration

- Demographics of patients accessing Transitionz
- ★ Length of stay in Transitionz
- Diagnosis and impairment level mix
- Outcome measures used over time
- Patient outcome (using outcome measures)






The Transitionz unit


Overall Aim: To assess and evaluate the TR programme

# CONCLUSION

- ★ Demographic variables had no impact on the differences in outcomes, including age.
- Higher level impairments did not perform as well in outcome measures
- Outcome measures need to reflect the intention of the service.
- ★ During TR stay function continues to improve.
- Delayed discharge concerns averted: average length of stay 25 days.
